This past summer the TSJCL ventured off to Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky to compete at the seventy-fifth National Junior Classical League convention. This year the Texas delegation brought 177 JCLers, 36 Sponsors and Chaperones, along with 3 SCLers, for a grand total of 216 members of the TSJCL. Also many Texans really enjoyed seeing Andrew Margrave serve on the National Board this year as 1st VP. This year's convention really started with a bang as all of Texas jumped right into competing, whether it was an early morning Ludi sport, Certamen, or yet another test. When they were not competing, many students found themselves at many of the fun events happening constantly around the campus: from Art viewing, to eating, to strolling through the Bazaar, or to the dances. There was not a single wasted moment at the convention this year.



As it got later in the convention many were greeted with the usual near end of convention events such as That's Entertainment, hosted by Brendon Walsh our TXSCL President and newly elected NSCL Parliamentarian, the first Texan to be an SCL officer in twenty years. However, the most important of all were the awards assemblies and Final Certamen rounds.

For Certamen, Texas put through three teams, one in each level. Unfortunately our Novice and Intermediate teams were eliminated in the semi-final rounds. However, our advanced Certamen moved on to the finals round where they placed third in the nation. And in World Series of Certamen, a team of Texas teachers was also eliminated in the semi-final round. "But, hey, we all had fun," says world series player, Jennie Luongo.



Texas continued to bring home the gold in many events this year. Whether it was Advanced Grammar, Costumes, Illustrated Quotation, or Ultimate Frisbee, Texas competitors were there and dominated the category that they had been working for. Texas also managed to win spirit on the Spirit day theme of Kentucky Fried Classics day.

And so ends another successful convention for the Texas delegation.

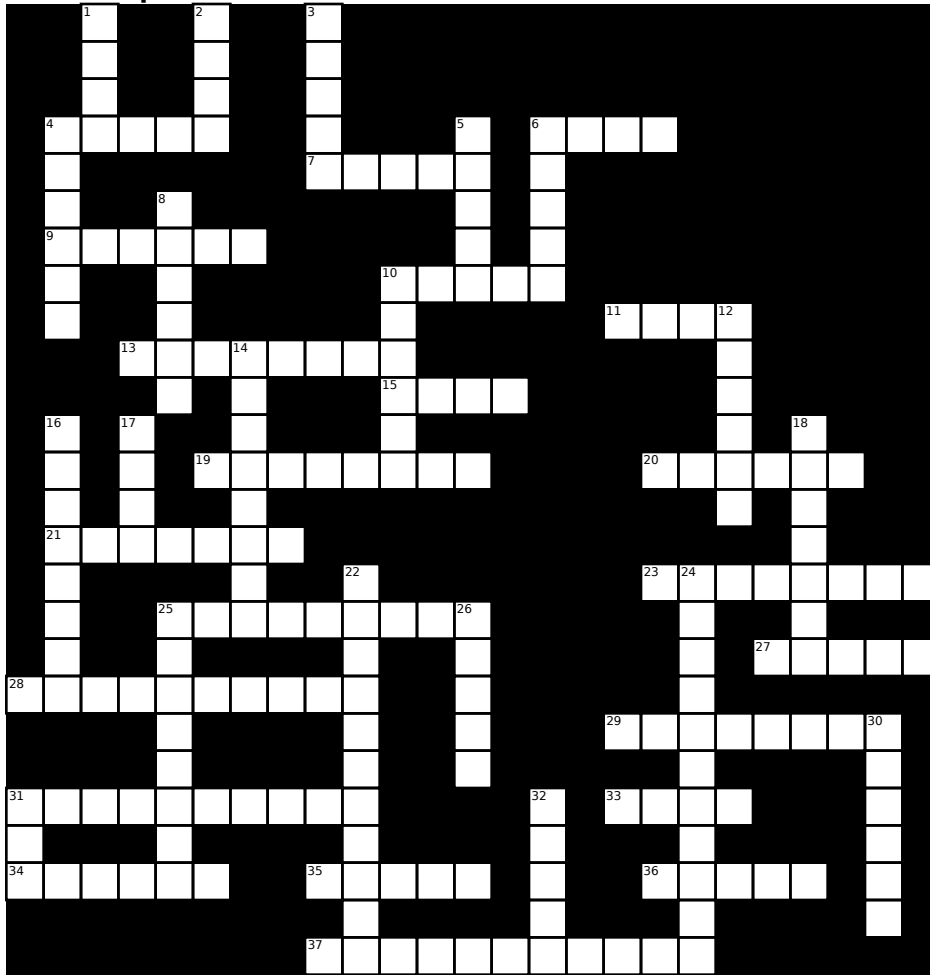
