# **2013 NJCL CONVENTION AT UNLY**

Dear fellow TSJCLers,

In late July of this this past summer TSCJL members numbering in the hundreds journeyed to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) to be apart of the 60th annual National Junior Classical League Convention. This year the Texas delegation alone contributed well over 200 students, sponsors, and chaperones to the Convention. Whether it meant attending art viewings, playing ludi sports, going to one of the dances, attending lectures, watching That's Entertainment!, or



even just browsing the Bazaar, there was certainly always something fun to do. One TSJCLer Sam Robinson is on record as stating that the 2013 Convention was "like a really rad week-long camping trip with all my bros [sic]". All of this in combination with an early chance to experience living on a college campus provided all those in attendance with a splendidly busy week in Las Vegas.



One of the most anticipated events of the whole Convention every year is the talent show, That's Entertainment!, which this year saw 5 of the 11 acts being performed by TSJCLers, proving just how much talent there is in the Texas delegation. In fact, two Texas acts placed in the top three, being Emily Jones and her partner from Indiana, Michael Keller, who received 3rd place for their percussion arrangement, and violinist Ben Chilton and vocalist Young Jang, who won first place for their sensual musical performance.

Three teams represented Texas in Certamen at the

Convention, one in each level. The Novice and Advanced teams of Texas made it as far as the semi-final rounds, placing 7th and 8th in the nation, respectively. However, the Texas Intermediate team succeeded in making the finals, impressively placing 2nd in the nation.

As for the other awards bestowed on Texas students, it goes without saying that the TSJCL excelled in every area, whether it was Latin Grammar, Classical Mythology, Graphic Arts, various Ludi sports, or any other event offered at the Convention. Also, congratulations are in order for Trace Turner being elected to the 2013-2014 TXSCL Parliamentarian and NSCL Editor positions, as well as TSJCL state chair William Lee being elected to the position of National Certamen Coordinator. Also, it is worth noting that in this past year Texas grew in membership more than any other state.

# LATIN DECLARED OFFICIAL U.S. LANGUAGE


